



HENRY E. MILLSON AWARD FOR INVENTION

The Henry E. Millson Award for Invention focuses on textile invention. The invention should be recognizable as an innovation, and will be judged solely on its merits and its impact on the U.S. textile, fiber, polymer, and medical industries. It is not necessary that the invention be patented. The Millson Award is not limited to citizens of the US or to members of AATCC. It may be given to more than one individual or to a company, and may be given posthumously. If given to more than one individual, the monetary award of US\$1,000 will be divided among the award recipients. Each recipient will receive an award plaque.
